

Sterne Kessler PTAB Team Shines in Latest Win for Volkswagen Over Car Headlight Tech

Sterne, Kessler, Goldstein & Fox secured a final written decision finding all challenged claims unpatentable in an *inter partes* review at the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office Patent Trial and Appeal Board (PTAB) on behalf of Volkswagen Group of America, Inc. The subject patent, U.S. Patent No. 10,894,503, relates to vehicle headlight systems that provide adaptive illumination to prevent glare. Read the final written decision, finding all challenged claims 20–25 and 59–64 of the '503 patent unpatentable, <u>here</u>.
